REQUEST OF THE IRAQI GOVERNMENT UNDER ARTICLE 11,  
PARAGRAPH 2, OF THE COVENANT.

Letter from the Government of Iran to the Secretary-General.

(Translation)

Imperial Legation of Iran,  
Berne, May 4th, 1936.

Sir,

Negotiations being now in progress between my Government and the Royal Government of Iraq with a view to arriving at a direct agreement on the subject of the dispute which the Iraqi Government referred to the Council of the League Of Nations by a request dated December 5th, 1934, the two Governments have agreed to have the examination of that request withdrawn from the agenda of the next ordinary session of the Council.

The Royal Government of Iraq having already applied to the Secretariat accordingly<sup>(x)</sup>, I have the honour to inform you that the Imperial Government of Iran associates itself with that application.

I would ask you to bring the above to the knowledge of the Council, and I have the honour, etc.
